To develop ideas for interdisciplinary research and knowledge exchange projects related to care spaces



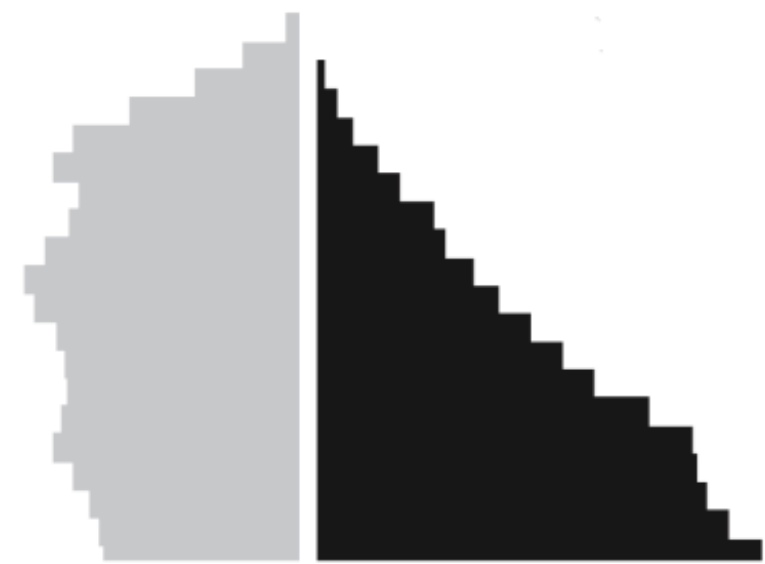
